- A 30-month IST project to develop scaleable monitoring platform for the Internet and promote the use of monitoring tools for improving services and technology. Started in April 2002.
- 9 partners from commercial, research and academic sectors:
  - TERENA, FORTH, IMEC, LIACS, CESNET, Uninett, FORTHnet, NETikos & Masaryk University.
- Developing a high-performance intelligent monitoring adapter, up to 10 Gbps.
  - Utilising standard PC architecture and providing simple installation.
- Developing an open and extensible architecture for network monitoring.
  - Provide common API for developing applications.
- Developing monitoring and measurement tools.
  - Packet Capture, Accounting, Flow-based Reporting, Threshold Alerting, Qos Monitoring, Intrusion Detection & DoS detection.
